Dr. Jayson Lusk

OCA / OCW / OJCA Joint Opening Session: OSU Ferguson College of Agriculture & College of Veterinary Medicine Update

Dr. Jayson Lusk is the Vice President and Dean of Agricultural Programs at Oklahoma State University, where he also holds the rank of Regents Professor. He leads the Ferguson College of Agriculture and oversees OSU Extension and OSU Ag Research. Dr. Lusk rejoined OSU after serving as department head at Purdue University and was previously a faculty member in OSU's Department of Agricultural Economics from 2005 to 2013. His extensive scholarly work includes over 270 peer-reviewed scientific journal articles and six books, with expertise in food policy, emerging food issues, consumer behavior, and livestock and meat technology and marketing. He has served on numerous boards, testified before both houses of the United States Congress, and is a sought-after speaker and expert media source. Dr. Lusk earned his Ph.D. in agricultural economics from Kansas State University and his undergraduate degree in food technology from Texas Tech University. He and his wife, Christy, have two adult sons, Jackson and Harrison, and they are happy to call Stillwater, Oklahoma their home.



Dr. Carlos Risco

Dr. Risco received his DVM degree in 1980 from the University of Florida and advanced clinical training as an intern in private dairy practice at the Chino Valley Veterinary Associates, Ontario, California. He is a diplomate in the American College of Theriogenologists. From 1982 to 1990, he was a full partner at Chino Valley Veterinary Associates, a 9 veterinarian dairy practice. In 1990, he joined the faculty as an Assistant Professor at the University of Florida College of Veterinary Medicine. He became full Professor in 2002, was Chair of the Department of Large Animal Clinical Sciences from 2012 to 2018, and named Professor Emeritus in 2018. He is currently Dean of the Oklahoma State University, College of Veterinary Medicine.



He has served as the Extension Livestock Marketing Specialist since he came to Oklahoma State University in 1989. He has B.S. and M.S. degrees from Montana State University and a Ph.D. from the University of Illinois. He previously served as the Superintendent of the Southeastern Colorado Range Research Station in Springfield Colorado. His main program areas at Oklahoma State University include livestock market outlook and marketing/risk management education for livestock producers. Derrell also works in the area of international livestock and meat trade with particular focus on Mexico and Canada and the North American livestock and meat industry. He lived in Mexico on sabbatical in 2001 and has developed an extensive knowledge of the Mexican cattle and beef industry and the economics of cattle and beef trade between the U.S. and Mexico.

Davis Angus began in 1973 when Bud Davis purchased ten registered Angus cows, which formed the foundation of the herd that Jim and his wife, Debbie, later expanded with cattle from various sources. By 1995, they introduced artificial insemination, leading to cattle with desired carcass traits and show ring appeal. Shifting from cotton farming to registered seed stock sales, they started the annual Value Genetics Bull and Female Sale. Partnering with Buffalo Feeders allowed them to receive detailed data on their cattle, aiding in continuous improvement. Jordan Davis's involvement in showing cattle further propelled their focus on quality beef production. Now, with the addition of their son-in-law Nocona Cook and two grandsons, the family tradition continues. Davis Angus remains dedicated to enhancing their herd through advanced techniques, aiming to leave a lasting heritage for future generations on the red hills of Western Oklahoma.
